#### Criteria

## I. Initial Approval Criteria

- A. Chronic Lymphocytic Leukemia (CLL) (must meet all):
  - 1. Diagnosis of CLL;
  - 2. Used in combination with rituximab;
  - 3. Disease is relapsed or refractory after at least 1 prior therapy (eg, purine analogues [fludarabine, pentostatin, cladribine], alkylating agents [chlorambucil, cyclophosphamide] ), or monoclonal antibodies [rituximab]).
    - \*Prior authorization may be required.

### **Approval Duration**

All Lines of Business (except Medicare): 6 months

# II. Continued Therapy Approval

- A. All Indications in Section I (must meet all):
  - 1. Auto-approval based on lookback functionality within the past 120 days as a proxy for member responding positively to therapy.

### **Approval Duration**

All Lines of Business (except Medicare): 12 months
